As per Year 11 Annual Examinations timetable published by the Educational Assessment Unit (EAU), the SCDP examination for this scholastic year will be held on Monday 2nd March 2026.

As has been the case in the past three scholastic years, this examination will be held online and will include 60 multiple choice questions, some of which will feature recorded clips, diagrams and pictures.

Heads of Schools are kindly requested to nominate one SLT member who will oversee this examination that will last a maximum of 1 hour 15 minutes and must be held in a Computer Lab. Invigilation duties are not to be assigned to SCDP Teachers and schools are kindly requested to ensure that a Computer Lab technician is available.

Students will require their correct ilearn credentials to ensure successful login. It is highly recommended that this is double checked days ahead of the actual examination.

The link to the online examination will be forwarded to schools via the nominated SLT member 15 minutes prior to the start of the examination.

During the previous days, a saved copy of all recorded clips, diagrams and pictures included in the examination will also be sent to schools. These are only to be used in case of a power failure or major technical glitch. If this is the case, the printed paper supplied is to be used by students to tick their answers. To this effect, it is important that schools have fully charged laptops on standby.
