Reference is made to Circular DSVP 072/2025, disseminated on 12<sup>th</sup> December 2025.

As part of the opportunity being offered to Year 11 students following the ICT C3 subject, students who missed their Year 11 ICT C3 examination will be given the opportunity to sit for a Year 11 ICT C3 catch-up examination.

This opportunity applies strictly to the ICT C3 written examination and does not include coursework. Students who were absent for any reason — including illness, personal circumstances, or other forms of absenteeism — are eligible. Students who changed schools during their studies (cross-schooling) are also eligible. The Year 11 ICT C3 catch-up examination will be held on **18 April 2026 during the evening session**.

Year 11 students who missed the written examination are requested to register their interest in sitting for the catch-up examination through this [link](#) by no later than **Wednesday, 18 March 2026**. Registrations must be completed and submitted by the School Leadership Team. Kindly note, that this is not a re-sit, but a catch-up opportunity as explained above. Accordingly, if a student is registered for and/ or sits for this catch-up examination and is found to already have a recorded mark for that examination, the original mark will be retained.
